

For example, strap on our new deluxe F-27 folk dreadnought. Pick a lead melody on it, and your softest note reaches the back of the room. Or wail on it, and you get those ringing, singing big sounds that get an audience to stomping its feet. This is the new Conn sound. Dazzling and big. Fussy and soft. And sweet.

Or try the superb new C-7 classic. When you hold a C-7, you know it's a beautiful thing. Hit a simple G chord, or let the harmonics. The sound is fantastic. You feel it. The whole instrument quivers with tone.



## REASON BY REASON, HERE'S WHY THE NEW CONN GUITARS SOUND SO GOOD.


### Revolutionary acoustical engineering:

The new Conn's have been engineered to produce a bigger sound. The guitar body, itself, is a unique sound chamber, and in the dreadnoughts, has been newly configured to produce a gutsier bass and brighter treble.



### Uri-bone saddle and nut:

Because ours most closely resemble natural bone in density and hardness, strings vibrate cleanly, producing a clear, pure sound.



### New bracing:

The new tapered radial braces are precisely shaved. A brighter, more balanced sound is the result.



### Necks:

Conn's new neck fastening system reduces the wood mass inside the body of the guitar, which greatly improves resonance. Further, the new professional neck design lets the



player move up and down the fingerboard faster, more comfortably. That means you get more out of the Conn guitar with less effort.

### The wood:

Our woods are aged longer for stability and truer tone. And they're dried to a lower percentage of humidity. Less moisture means freer vibration, and better sound.

### Final assembly:

Precision electrostatic gluing bonds only where it's supposed to. You get a lasting, resonant sound chamber.

### Final finishing:

A new super-bright polyester finish in no way impairs the body's ability to vibrate, as do some finishes. And that means better sound.

### Workmanship:

You'll know your Conn Guitar is made right just by touching it. And you'll hear the bigger sound we've built into it the second you tune it.

# CONN CLASSICS



Gary and Irene Scott of Springfield, Mo., both own Conn guitars. Here is a C-21. His...ugh F-27, Irene's played guitar all her life, and has owned lots of instruments. The C-21 is her favorite.



**C-21** **Classic.** Conn's finest classic. Beautifully constructed to produce outstanding sound quality. Extremely responsive. 3-piece reinforced neck keeps the action right. Matched rosewood back and sides. Ebony fingerboard and bridge. Excellent voicing. A professional looking instrument at home on the stage or in your studio.



**G-31** Classic. Superior tone for classical music, and plenty of penetration for folk music, even in crowded auditoriums. Soprano block and sides look creamy and rich. It's really pretty.


**G-11** Classic. Try the superb new G-11. When you hold a G-11, you know it's a beautiful thing. Hit a simple G chord, or test the harmonics. The action is soft and quick. The sound is fantastic. You feel it. The whole instrument quivers with tone. It's a classical gas.



# CONN DREADNOUGHT



John Hertin of Norfolk, Nebraska leads a 22 player guitar church choir in magnificent folk masses. They all play Conn guitars. John's is an F-21.




**F-15 Dreadnought.** Super sound. That's the F-15 dreadnought. The lower bout is newly contoured for a booming bass. And tapered radial bracing inside the spruce top insures for brighter treble and overall better sound. Compare the F-15 to other dreadnoughts, and you'll see and hear the difference.



**F-21 Dreadnought.** If you're good, and want to look good and sound better, pick up an F-21. Sphere back and sides, heart tray, the dreadnought with a sound competitive to guitars costing lots more. An honest pickin' and strummin' instrument that's tough to put down.



**F-27 Dreadnought.** Our finest flat-top with big, ebony, bold sound. The F-27 will project with the best of 'em. And it whispers beautifully too. Heathy far-out sound. 3-piece resonant rosewood back and matching sides. Ebony fingerboard and bridge. Plenty of pearl. Gold-painted Grover tuning machines... it's there, friends.




# CONN 12-STRING DREADNOUGHT

**F-1812 12-String Dreadnought.** All of the F-12's features are built into this 12-string, including Gretsco's new neck aligning system, which keeps the action quick and easy always.

**F-2712 12-String Dreadnought.** There's only one reason to pick an F-2712... and that is to beat yourself. Resonance, big sound, responsiveness, balance, quick action... it's all here. A pleasure to play and to look at.




# CONN GRAND CONCERT




Mrs. Sette of Philadelphia is a classic and folk guitar teacher. Her guitar? Conn, of course. The F-18 model.


